
Undergraduate Enrollment Dubai Campus Fall 1998 to Fall 2020

Undergraduate Enrollment* Fall 1998 to Fall 2020














Student-Faculty Ratio* 2020-21



First-time Student Enrollment



First-time Student Enrollment by Campus Fall 2000 to Fall 2020









First-time Students Average GSC Scores



First-time StudentsAverage GSC Scores by Campus Fall 2006 to Fall 2020





First-time Students Baccalaureate One Year Retention Rate by Campus Fall 2004 to Fall 2020









First-time Students GSC Scores Fall 2020






Faculty by Gender









How would you rate your educational experience in the Academic Bridge Program?




How would you rate your educational experience in your Major?










Would you recommend Zayed University to friends or family?
